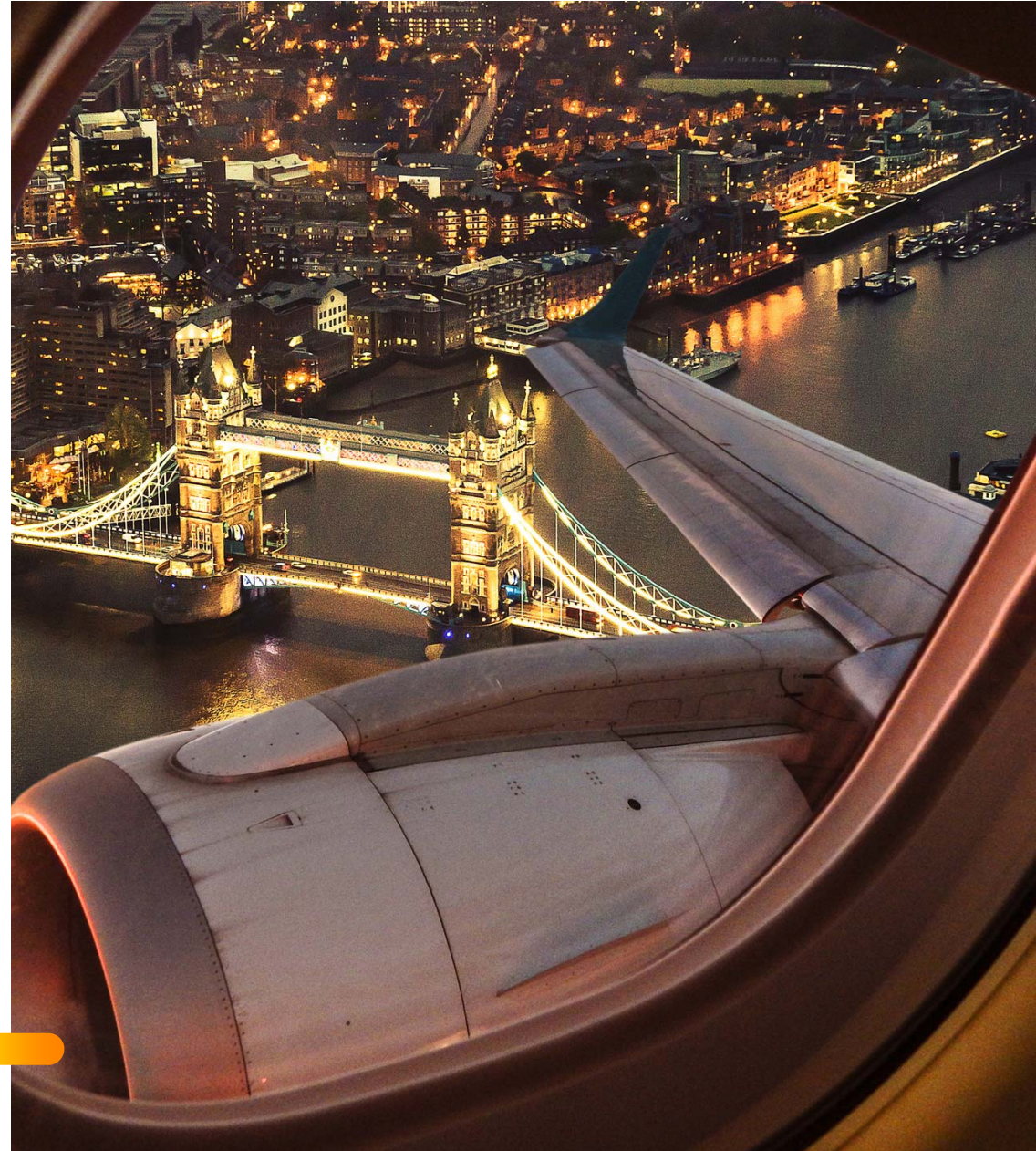

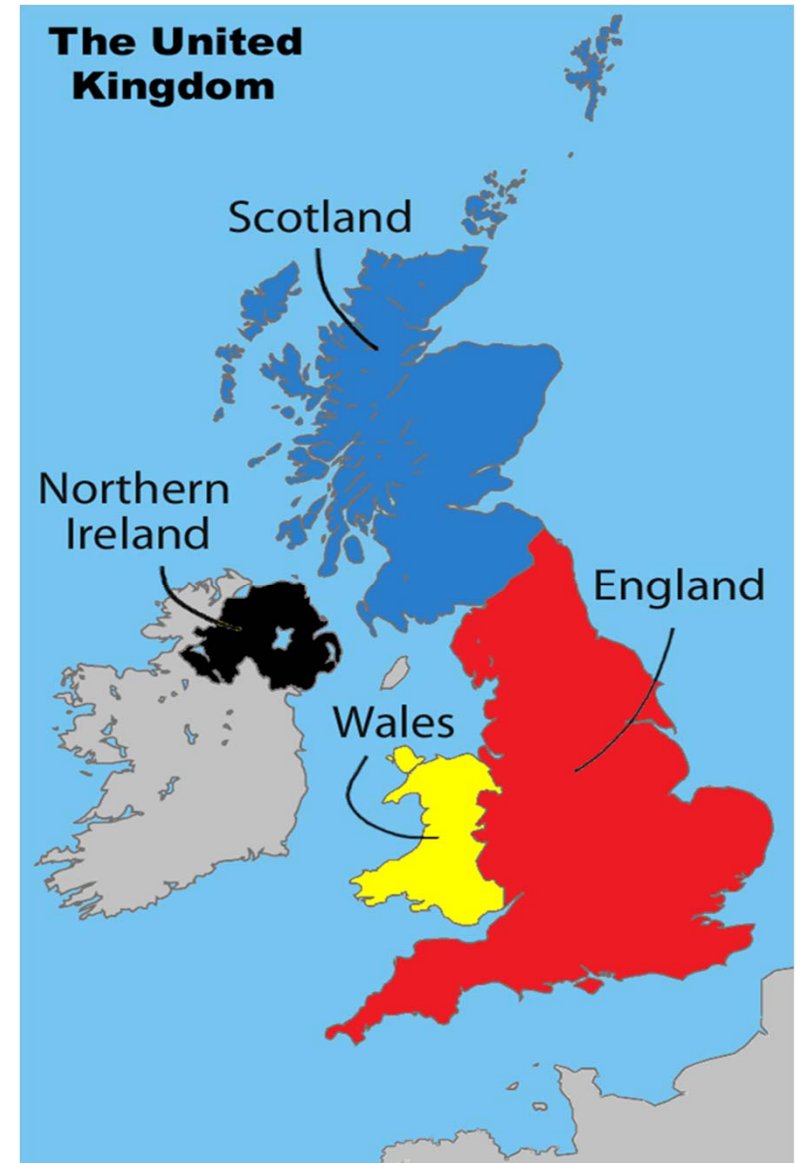

United Kingdom

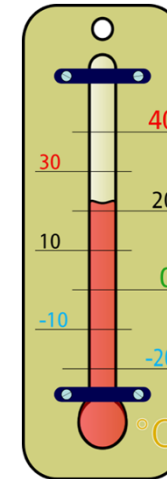

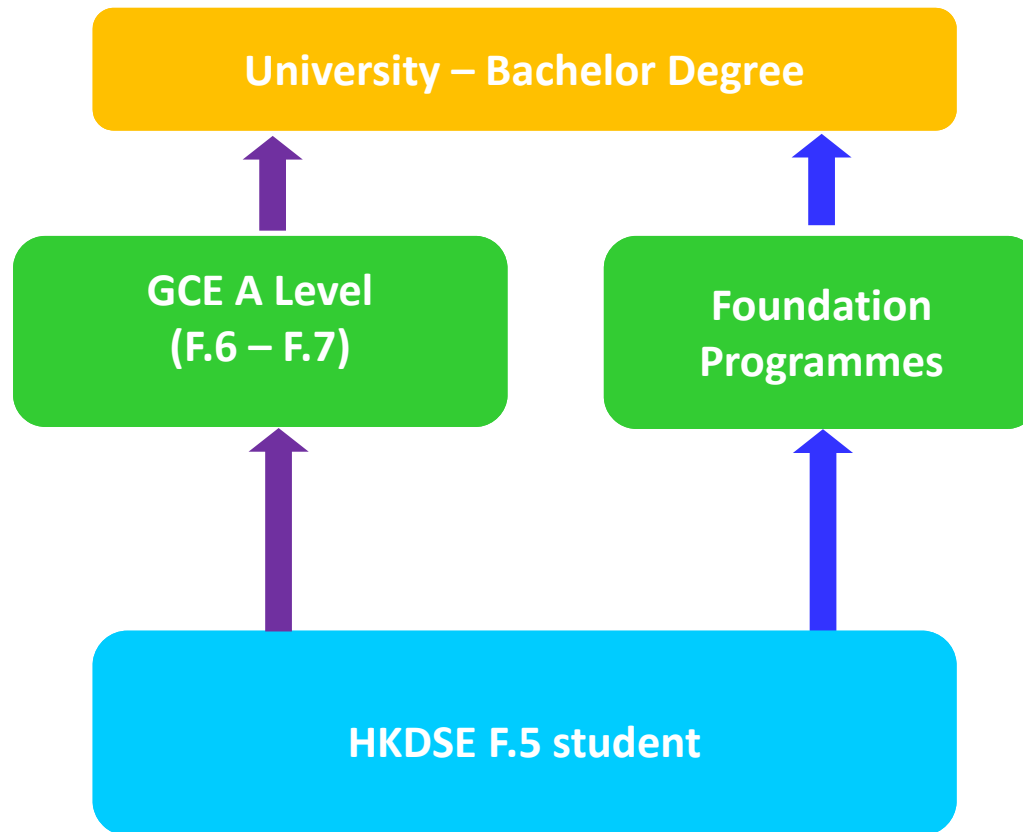

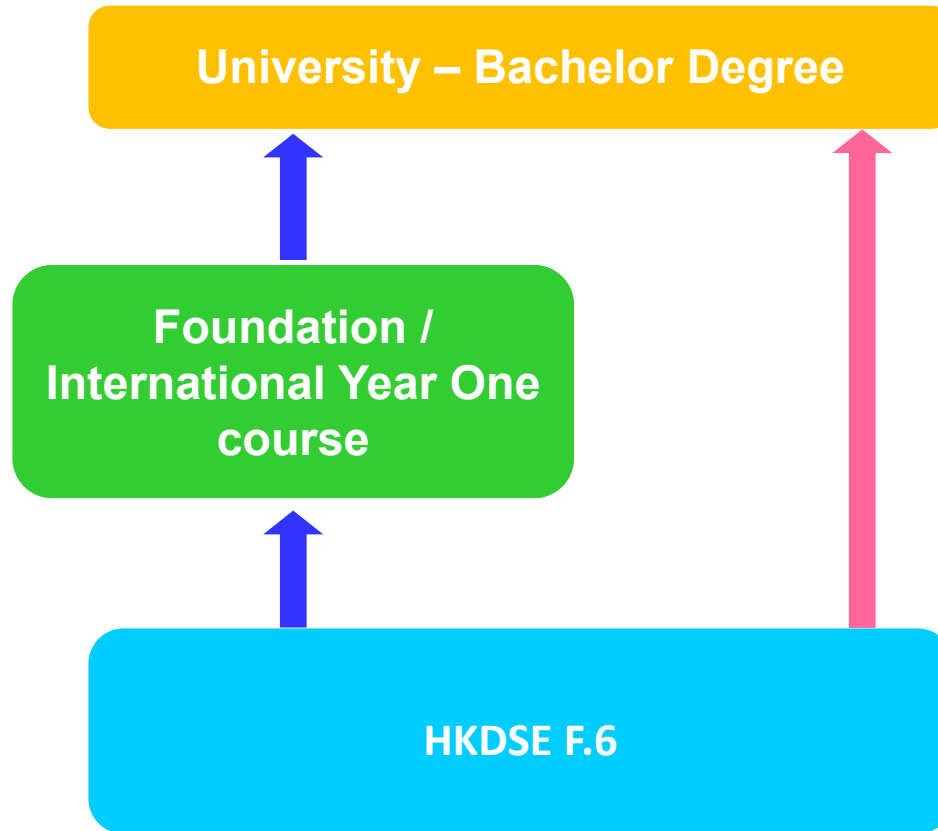
Pathway to Degree

Commencement Date

One main in-takes per year for University entry:

September (For ALL programs: Foundation, International Year One, UG & PG):

- UCAS application deadline: mid-Jan
- Applications normally close on 30th June for Undergraduate and April for Postgraduate

January (For Foundation, International Year One, selective UG programs or Postgraduate program):

- Applications normally close in Nov – Dec

UCAS

- UCAS (Universities and Colleges Admission Service)
- Students must apply through UCAS for studying undergraduate degrees in the UK – no matter they are British and EU students or as an overseas student
- Students submit a single application via UCAS's website with a list of up to five courses for which they are applying
- Costs (2021): £13 to apply to one course, £26 per student to apply to two or more courses



UCAS

- **15 October** – Application deadline for all medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine and veterinary science courses and for all courses at the universities of Oxford and Cambridge
- **15 January** – Application deadline for all other courses
- **30 June** – Students could still submit late application before that date
- Applications submitted by 15 January would usually receive all application outcomes (conditional/unconditional/unsuccessful) from all five choices by the end of March or by mid-May

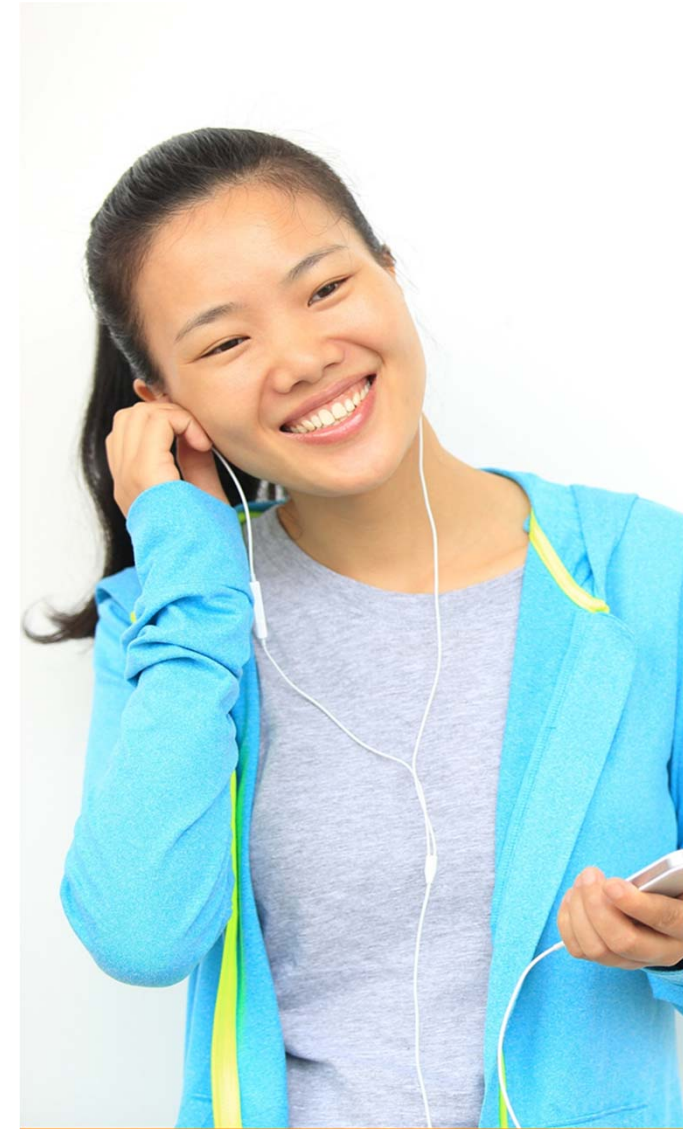

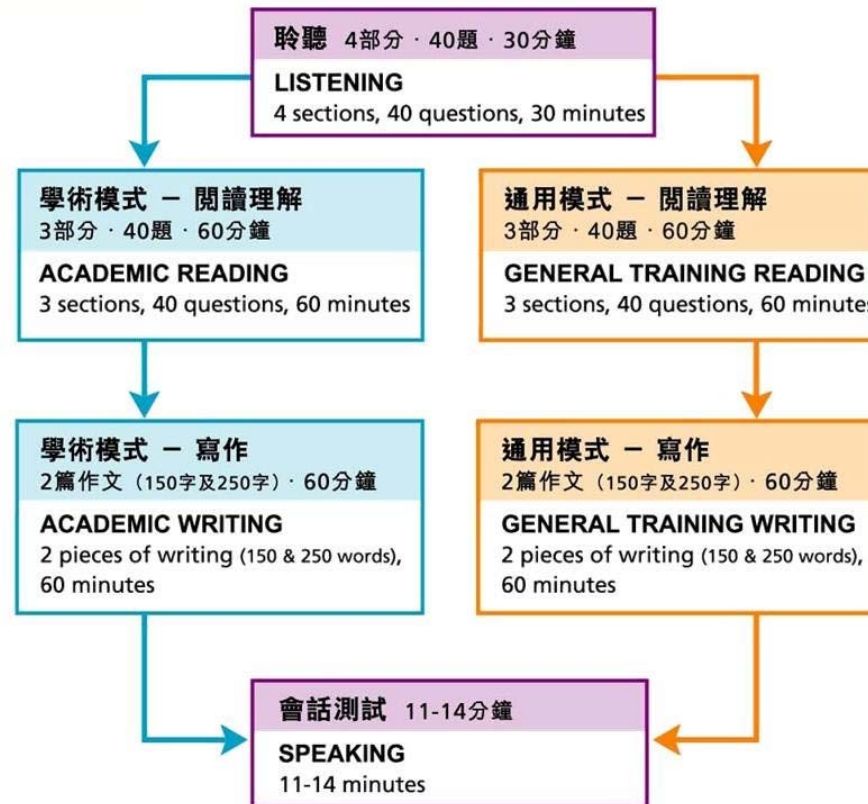
