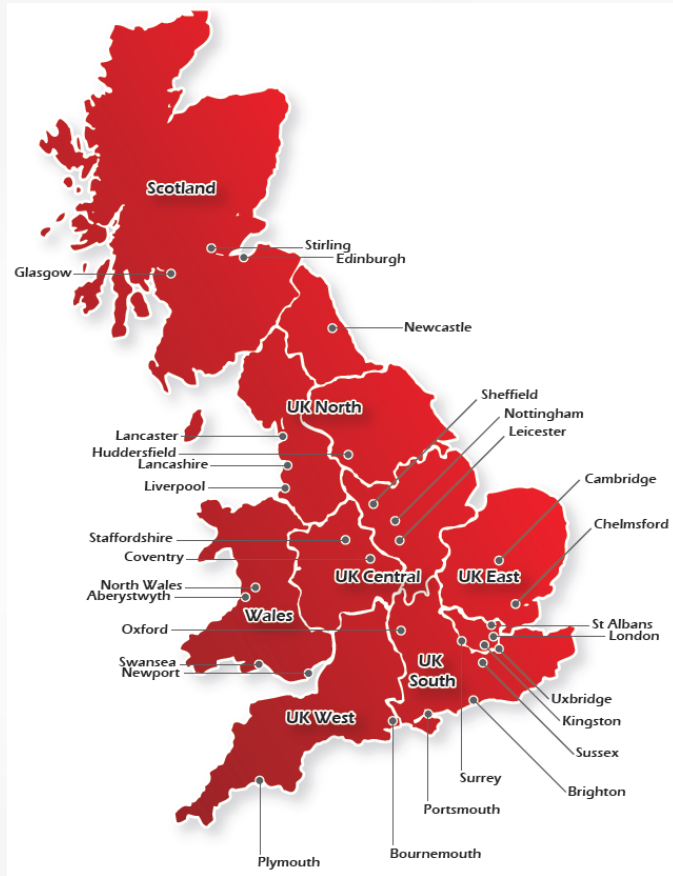

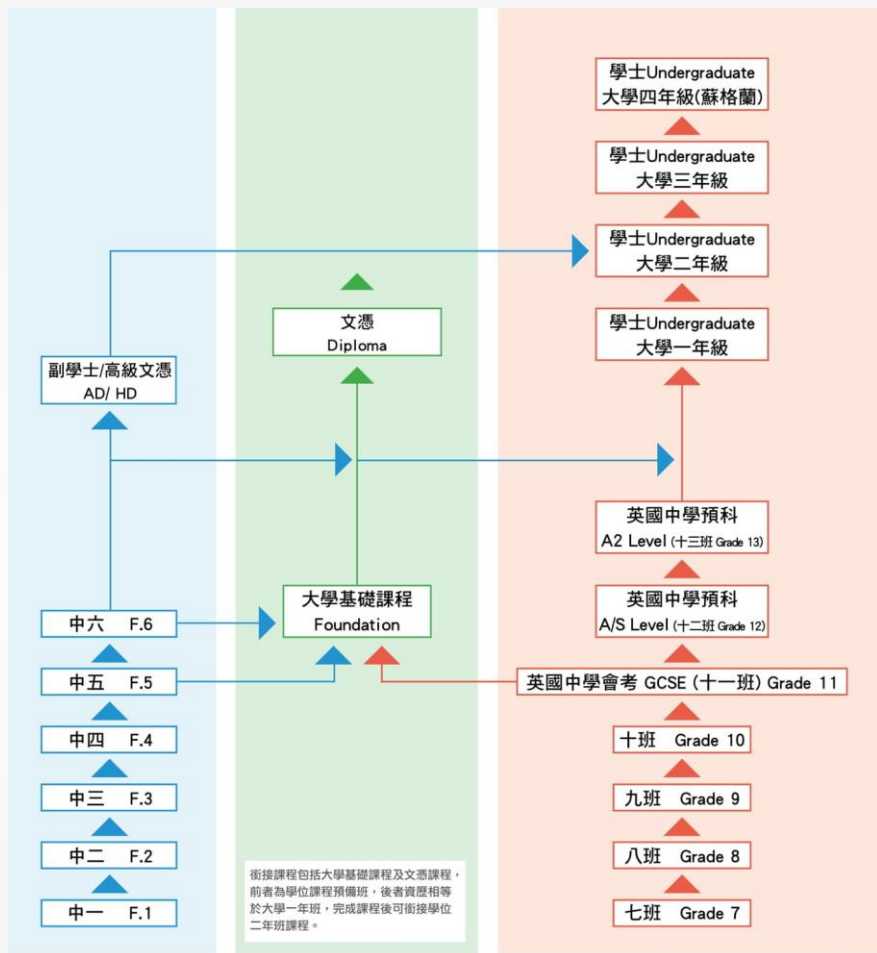

7. **£27** per student to apply to two or more courses
